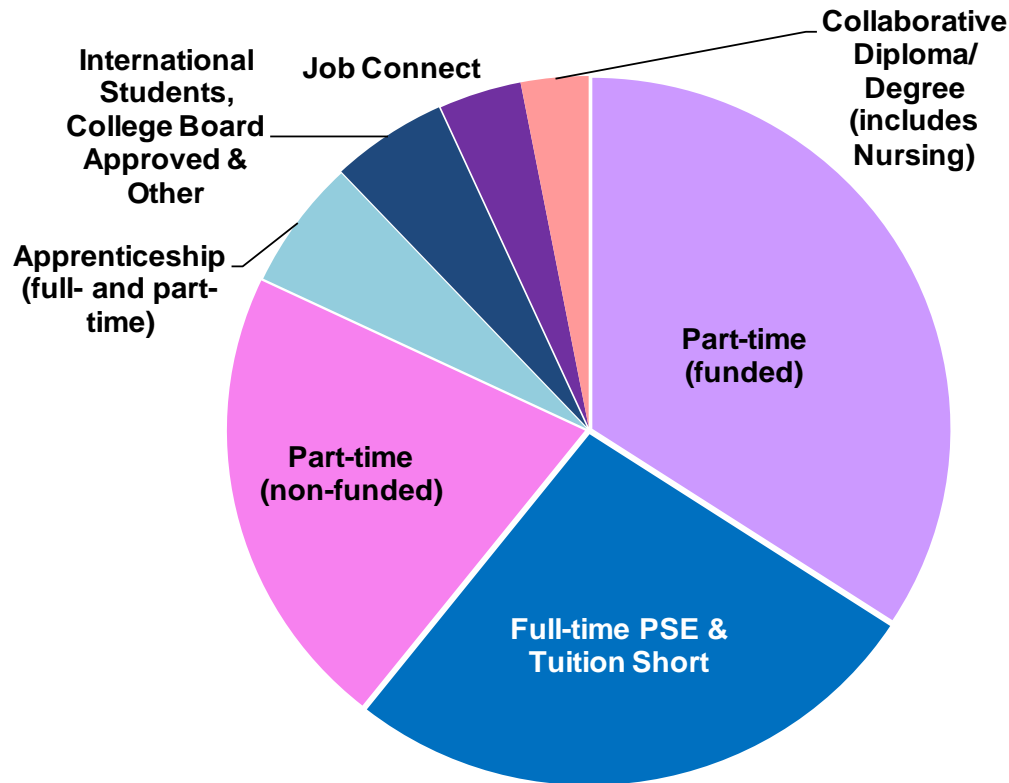


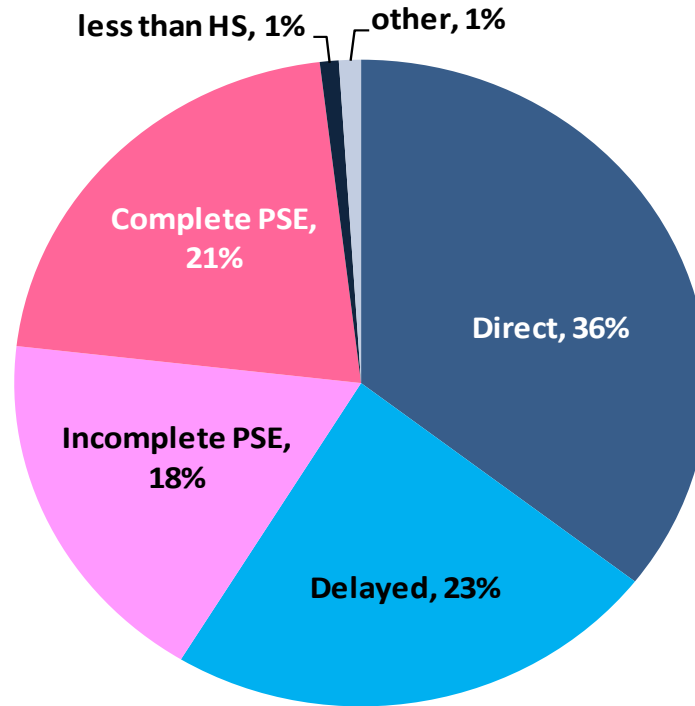
Learners/Clients Served by Ontario's Colleges

Pathways to College



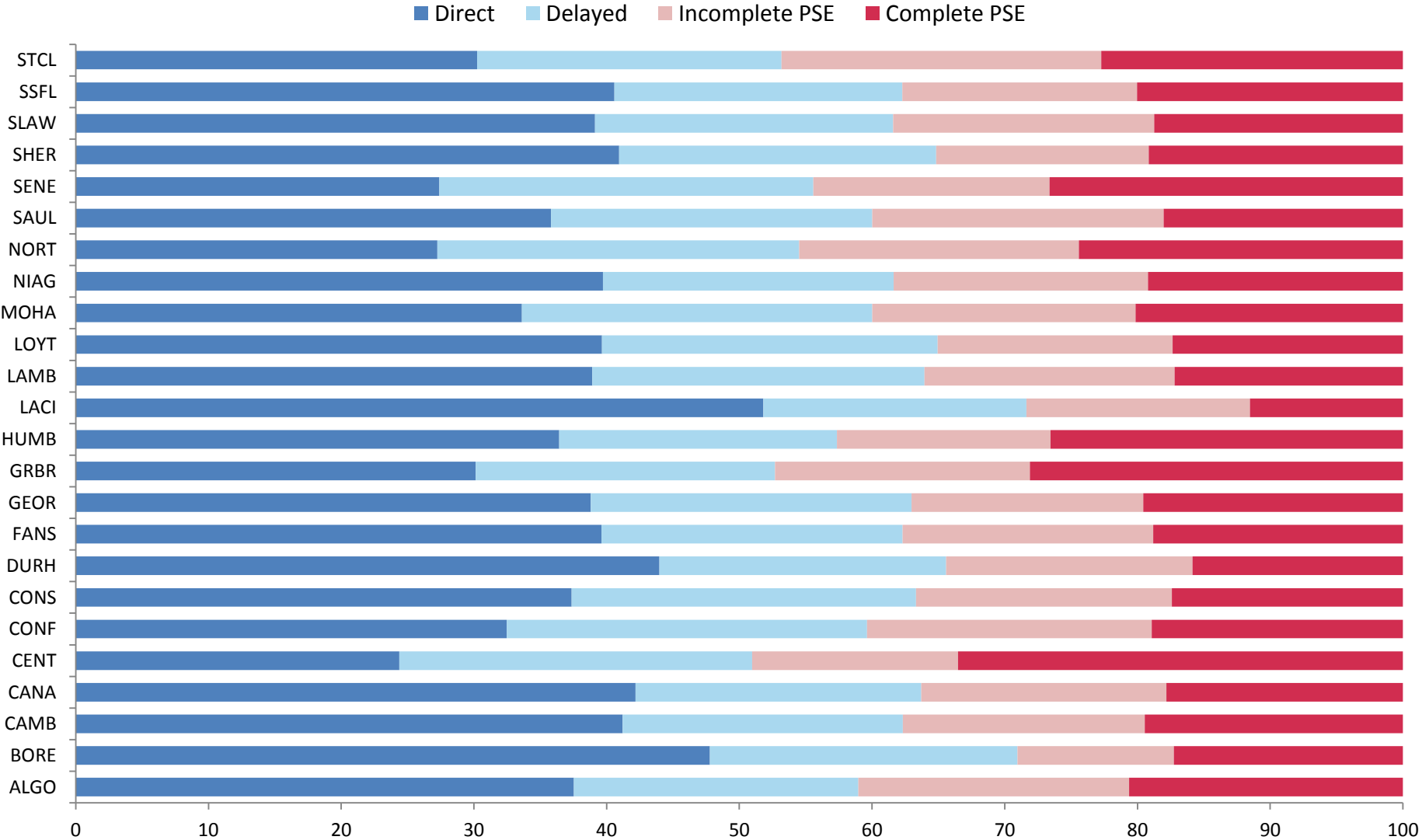
Direct: entered college directly from secondary school

Delayed: no prior PSE experience, but did not enter directly from secondary school

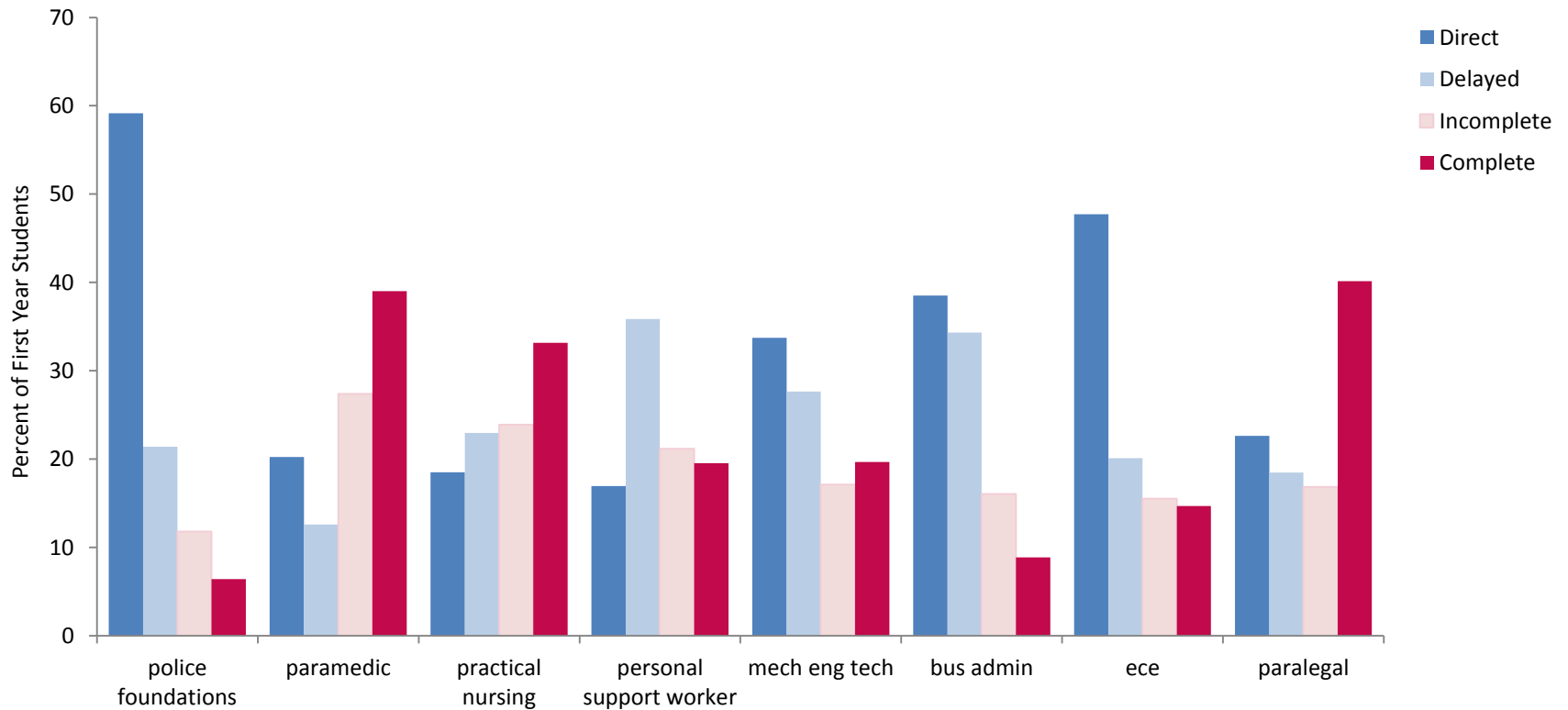
Incomplete PSE: previous PSE experience, without a completed credential

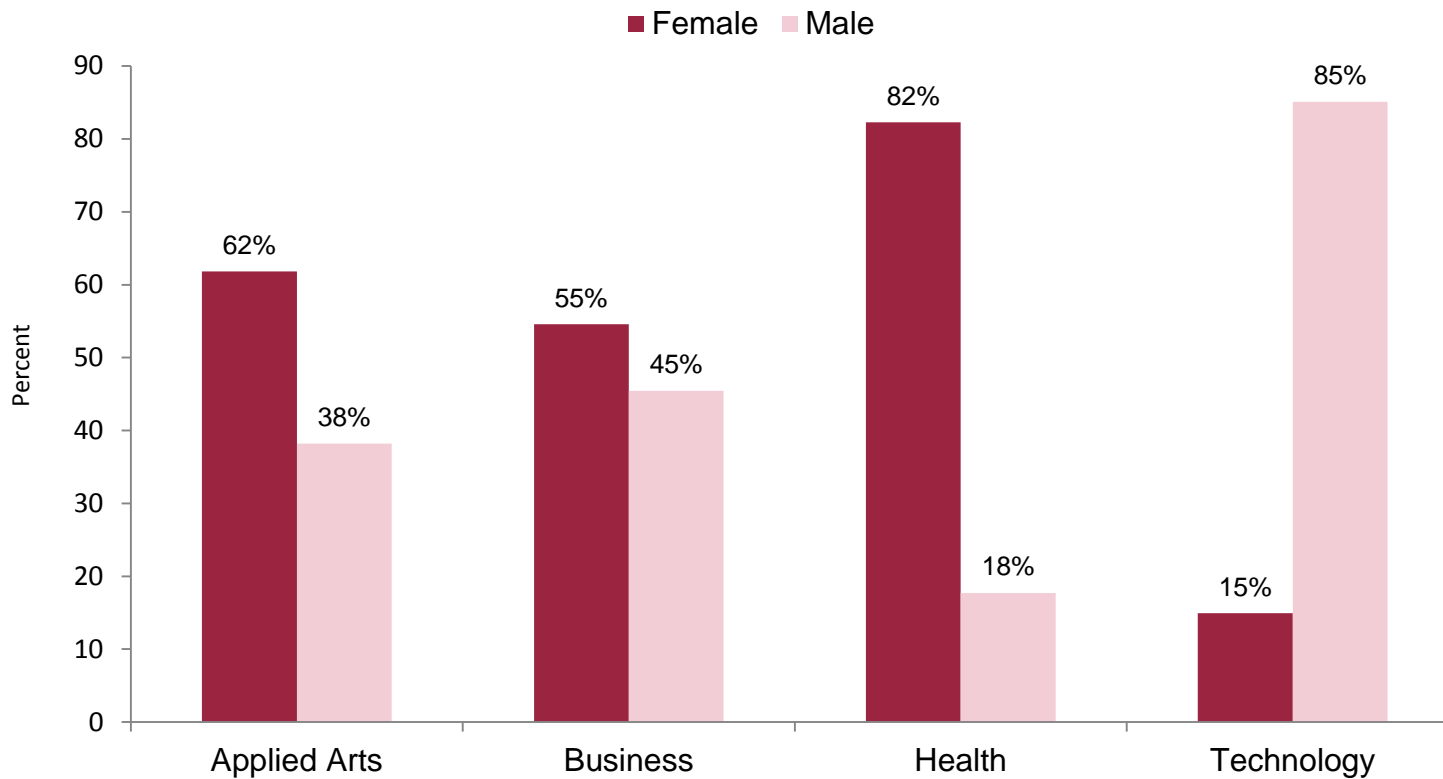


Programs by pathway: examples



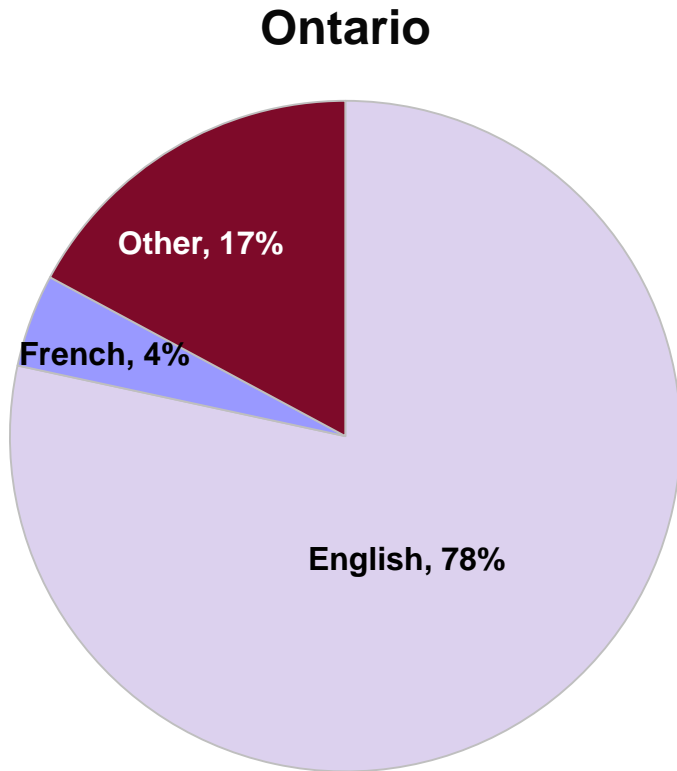
Demographics: Gender

Gender by Program Category

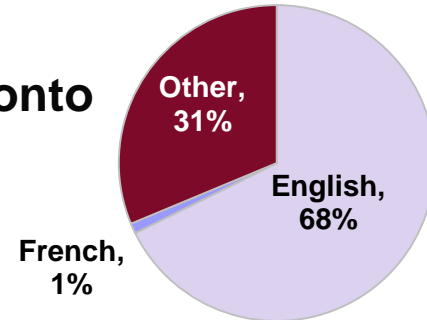

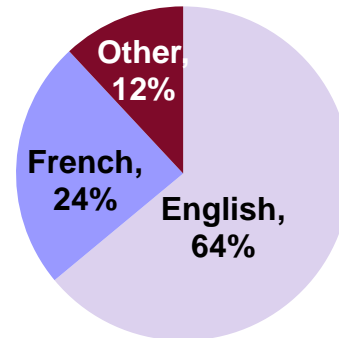

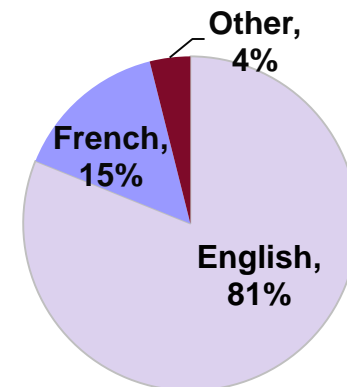

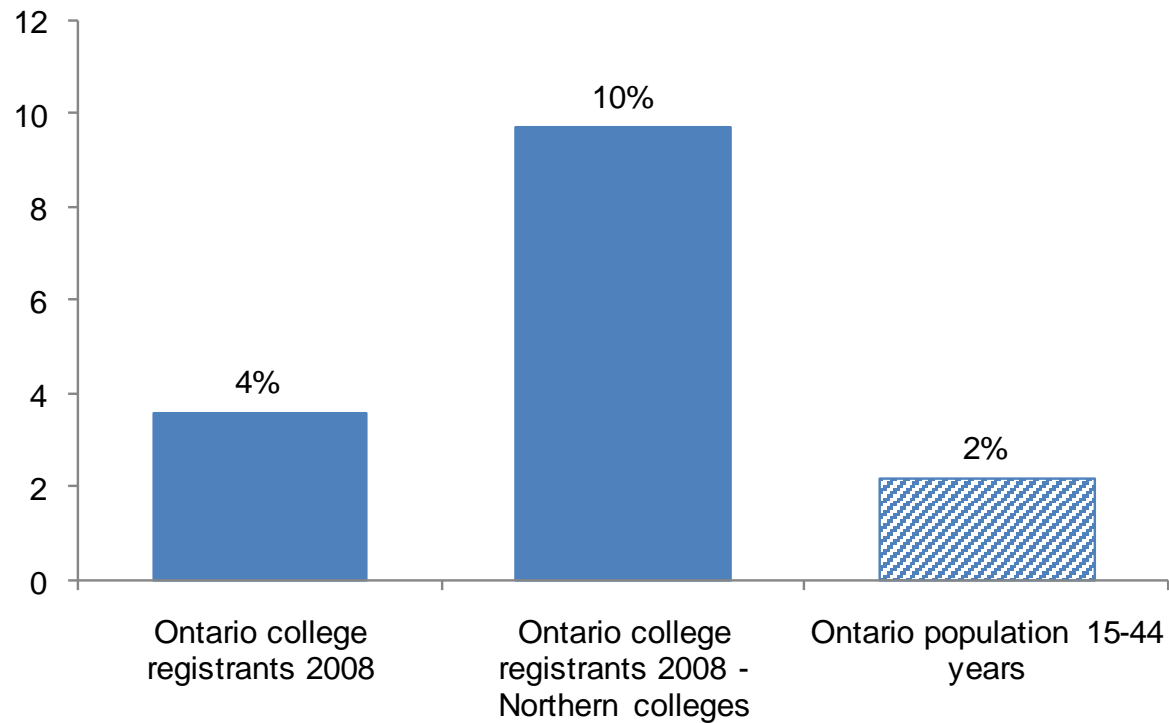

Aboriginal Students

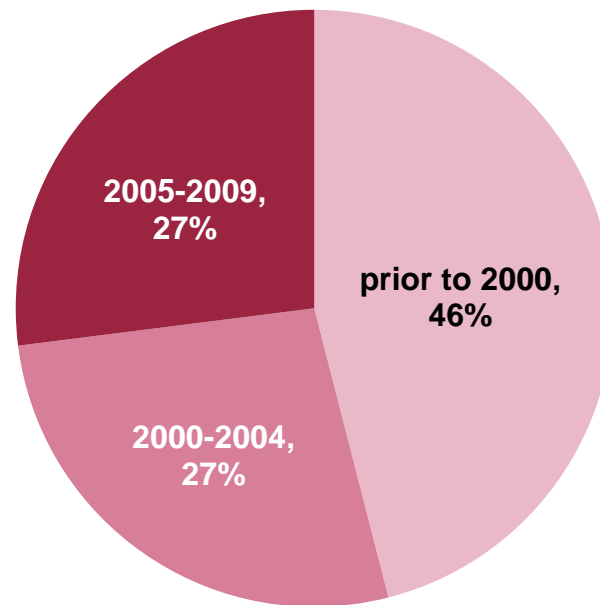

Year of Immigration

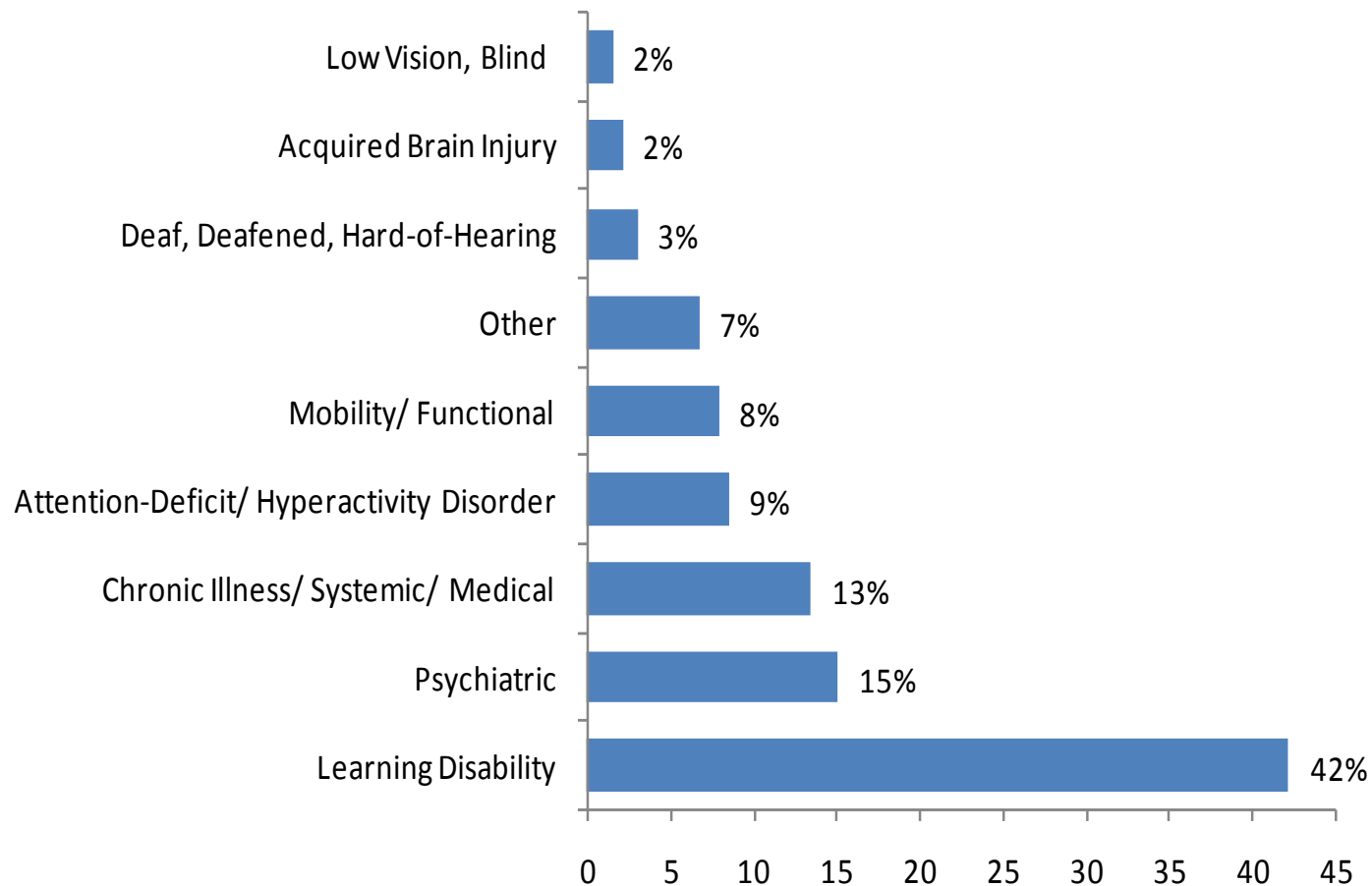

Students with Disabilities

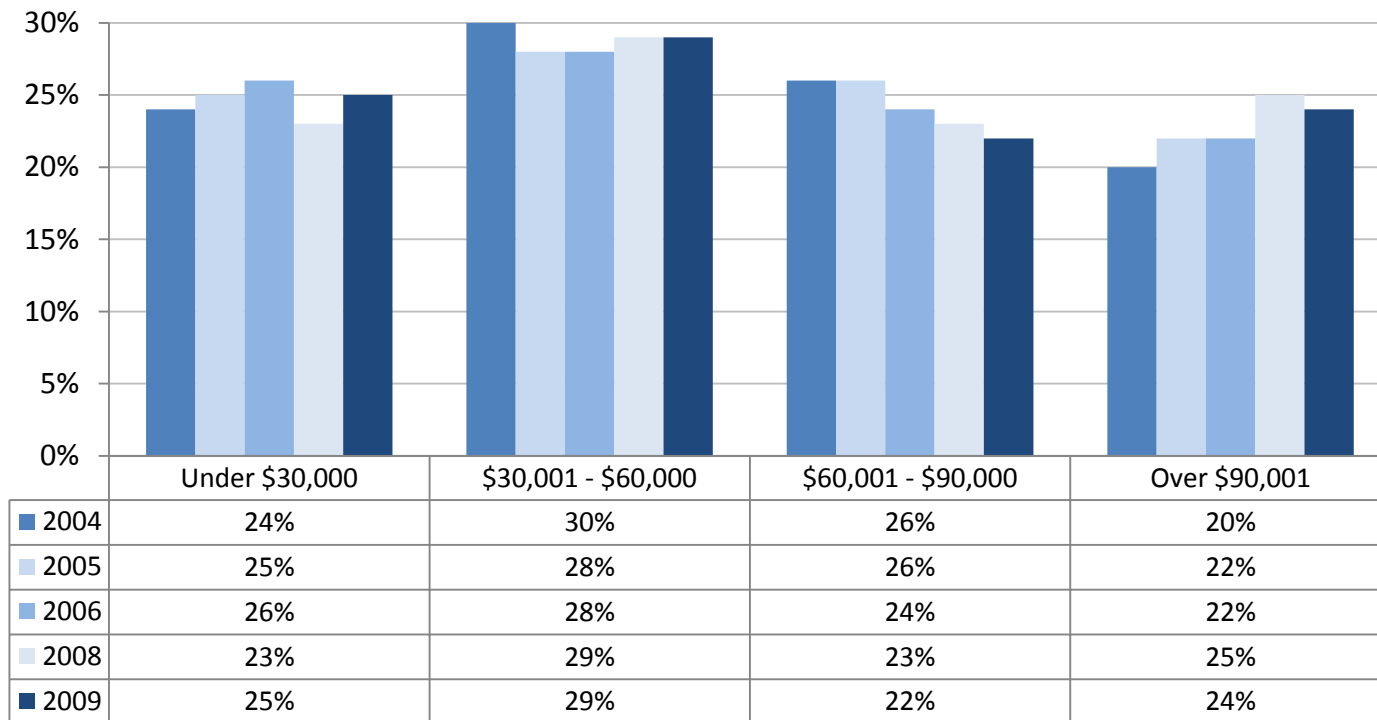
- About 12% of students make use of disability services at their college

Household Income

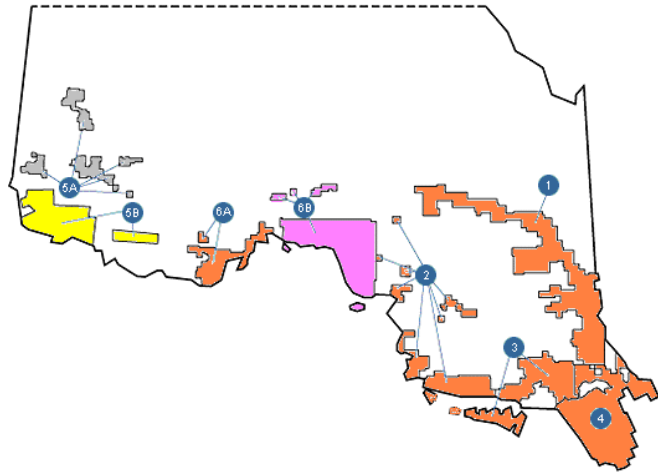
Distribution of College Applicants Across the Four Income Quartiles



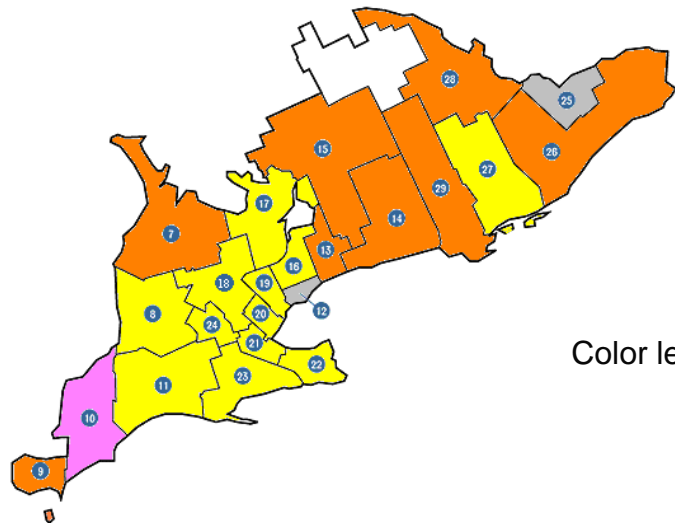
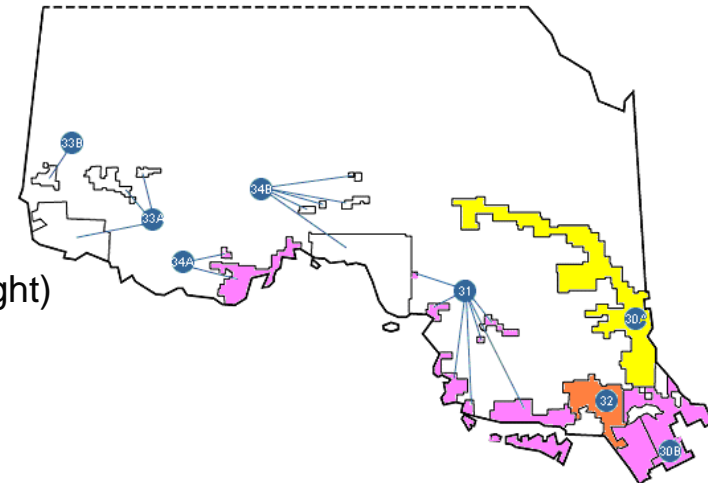

Distribution Across Ontario: Direct Registrants

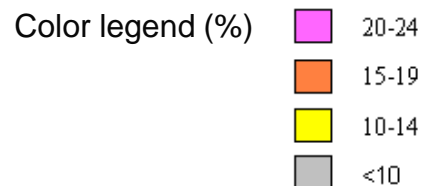
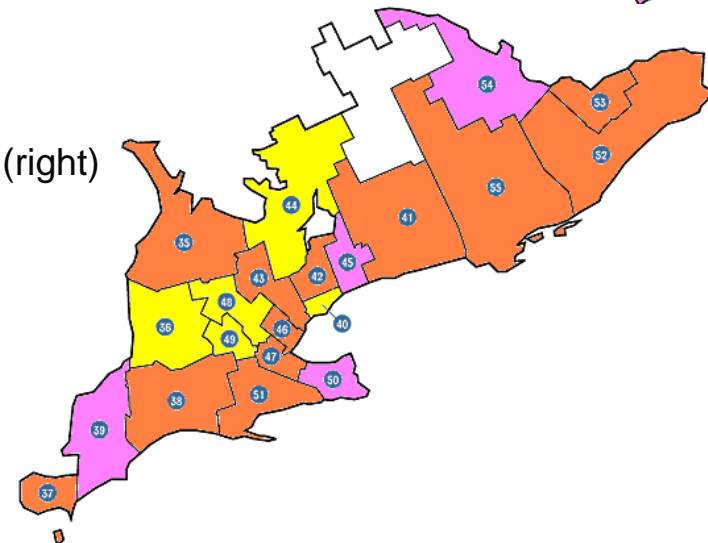
Percent of Grade 12/Year 5 Students Who Registered in College by School Board

District School Boards

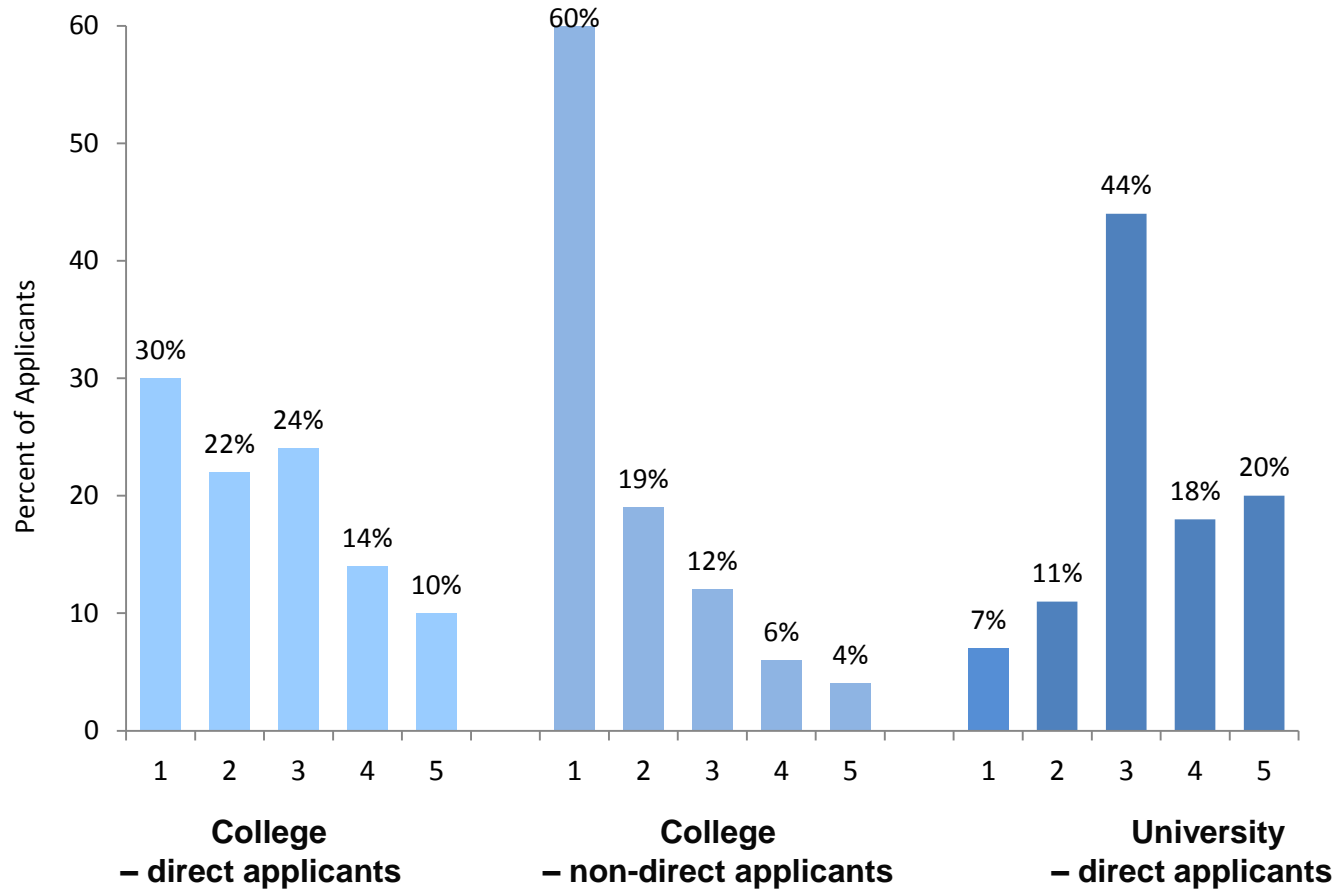


Southern Ontario

District School Boards



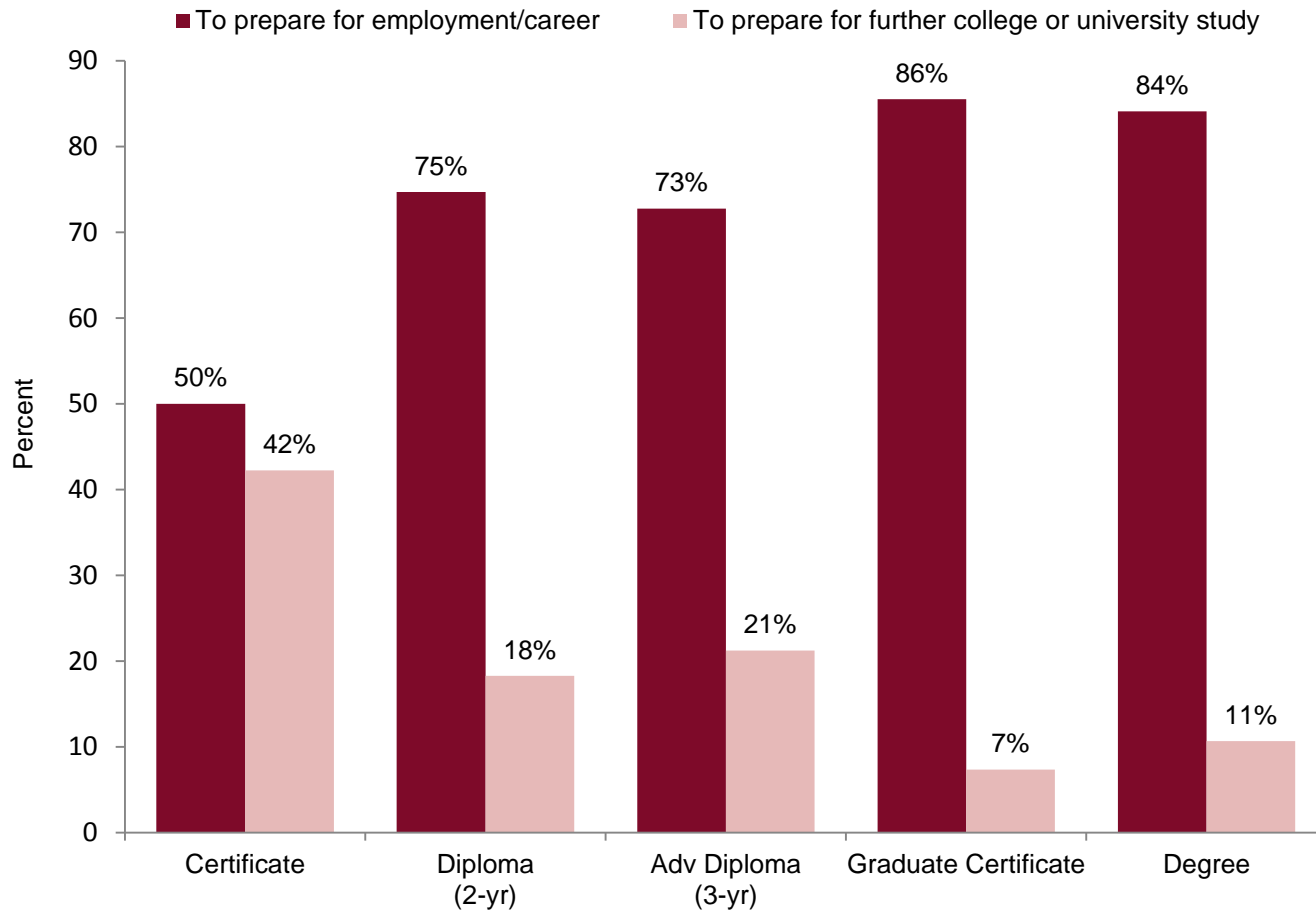
Mobility: PSE Applicants

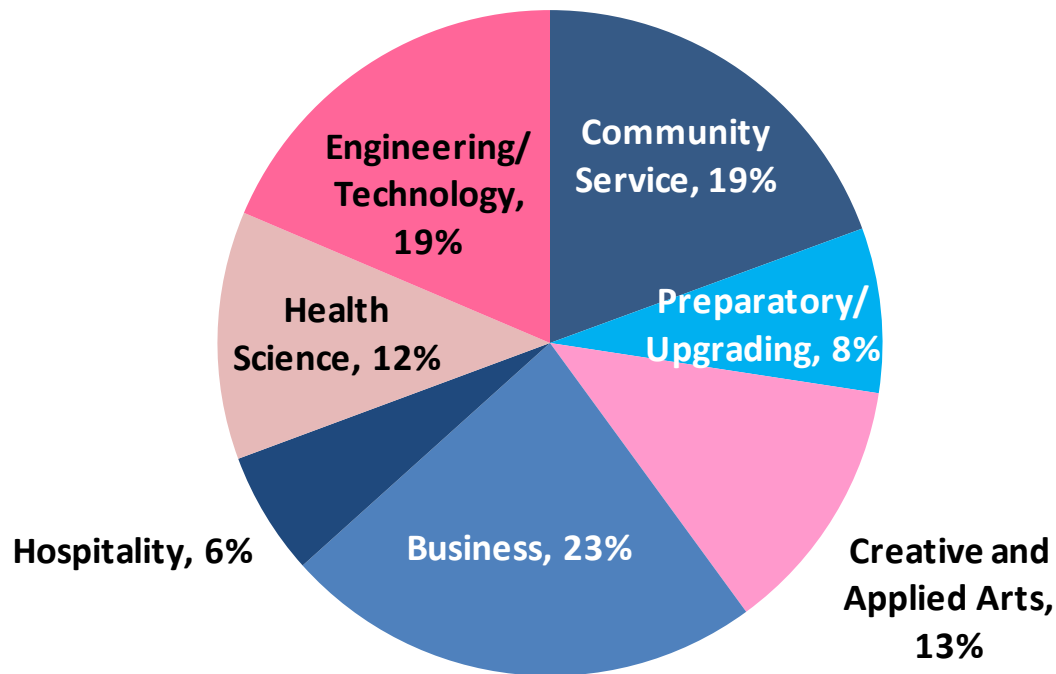
New starts by region and sector
